Job Summary:

The Financial Analyst Intern will be responsible for leading a cross-functional initiative to assess the financial impact of developing inventory safety stock and effective integration in the Sales & Operations Planning (S&OP) process. This project will be a combination of internal and external research, quantitative and qualitative analysis, and internal collaboration with Sales, Operations, and Finance. It will conclude with a final recommendation presentation to the company's Executive Team. This key project will help support the company's growth while enhancing current processes.

It is our intention for this internship to be a hybrid in-person and virtual work, as appropriate under current social distancing guidelines. There will be some initial in-person interactions required (with social distancing guidelines followed) to ensure adequate onboarding and project direction with the Finance team. This will be monitored on an ongoing basis.

Essential Functions:

- Learn Sales, Operations, and Finance team functions to understand internal landscape
- Develop a working understanding of King Technology industry, product line, and customers
- Learn company's supply chain strategy and structure as an input into project analysis
- Research different safety stock models and calculations; become company's subject matter expert on safety stock inventory modelling
- Create safety stock analysis model to quantify inventory cost and time required to build adequate safety stock above current Sales forecast
- Develop formal recommendation and presentation as a summary of all information gathered above
- As time allows
 - Research S&OP and Integrated Business Planning (IBP) best practices
 - Propose initial recommendation of how company should leverage above best practices into current business processes
